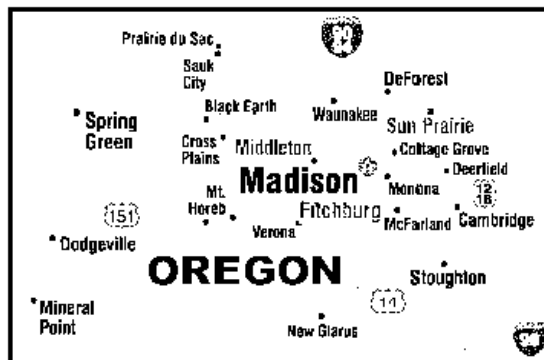

Tournament Information

Eligibility:

- This tournament is open to all recreational and competitive teams.
- State League teams may be asked to play up an age level.
- Teams are seeded.
- All teams and players must be USYSA registered.
- A valid player's pass, U11 and above, and medical release (district or state or from our web site) for each player INCLUDING GUEST PLAYERS must be presented at the time of registration.
- Up to 4 guest and/or club players with valid player passes will be allowed per team.
- For all guest players, a WYSA authorized guest player form must be submitted at registration.
- Player pass cards are NOT required for U9 or U10 teams.

Divisions:

Girls: U11-U19 Competitive
(U11 – U12 8v8, U13-U19 11v11)

Boys or Co-ed: U11-U19 Competitive
(U11- U12 8v8, U13-U19 11v11)

Girls and Co-ed: U9 and U10 Rec 6v6.

NOTE: If less than 5 U9 or U10 girls teams apply they will be combined to form a single division.

Games:

Each team will be scheduled to play a minimum of 3 games. U9-U12 games will be 50 minutes - two 25 minute halves.

***New for 2011:* U13-19 games will be 60 minutes - two 30 minutes halves

Tournament Information

Rosters:

Two (2) official USSF rosters authorized by your USYSA District Registrar completed with regular and alternate uniform numbers must be submitted at the time of check in. Guest / club players' names and numbers may be written on the official rosters for this tournament.

Roster Maximums

- U9 / U10 – 12 players
- U11 / U12 – 14 players
- U13 / U19 - 18 players

For out of state teams, a USYSA authorized travel permit is required at registration.

Awards:

Individual trophies will be awarded to players of winning and runner-up teams in age brackets U11 and above following their last game. Individual participation awards will be awarded to all U9 and U10 players.
